We look forward to seeing all of you there!! Bring your Valentine and be part of this fun evening!

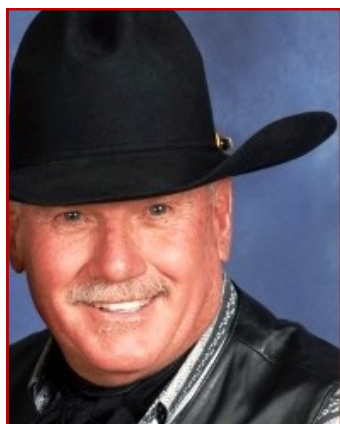
